Informative:

It is an offence to disturb wild nesting birds or to damage or destroy an active nest. Before any cuts are made, a thorough check should be made to ensure there are no birds nests currently in use (or are being built). Alternatively, do not carry out any works between 1 March and 31 August.

It is an offence to intentionally or recklessly damage, destroy or obstruct access to any place that a bat uses for shelter or protection. Before any arboricultural operations are undertaken a thorough check should be made for signs of bat activity. Expert advice should be obtained if there is evidence of bat activity.
