Thank you for your email and the attached fire document, however there is not enough information for our purposes.

We note that the application includes a document described as a fire statement document. However, legislation requires that a fire statement must be submitted on a form published by the Secretary of State, or a form substantially to the same effect, and include the particulars specified or referred to in the form.

From 1 August 2021, any application for planning permission for development that includes a relevant building is required to include a fire statement. Therefore, a completed fire statement, as described above, is needed to carry out an assessment for this application.

We aim to respond to enquiries within 21 calendar days from receipt of the fire statement.

The fire statement form and guidance on the completion of a fire statement, published by the Secretary of State, are available on <u>gov.uk</u>.
